TASK 2

Voice 1: You now have twenty (20) seconds to prepare.
(20-second gap)

Voice 1: You now have two (2) minutes to respond.
(2-minute gap)
(BEEP)

Interviewer: Good. Now, please describe your strengths in terms of an event you organized or participated in before this.

Voice 1: You now have thirty (30) seconds to prepare.
(30-second gap)

Voice 1: You now have two (2) minutes to respond.
(2-minute gap)
(BEEP)

Voice 1: End of Task 2

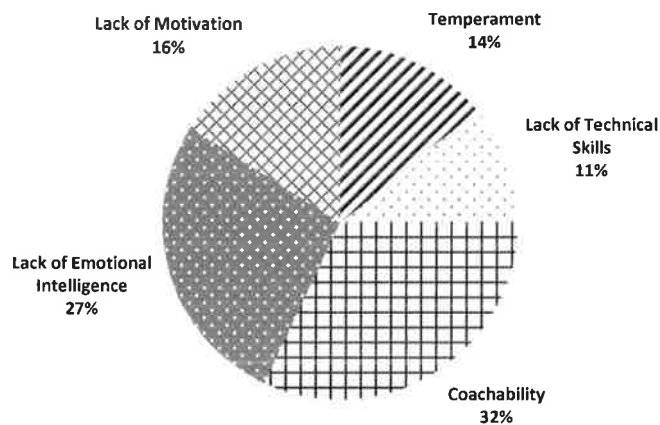
TASK 3

Situation
